## Mariner's Valley Two Maintenance Association Board Meeting Minutes

## April 25, 2019

Called to order 6:37pm by President Frank Alexich

Board members present: David Monk, Bill Kern, Marion Baricuatro, Frank Alexich, Mike Foley, Lonnie Bonds, Alan Gardner.

- 1. Irrigation Upgrade Discussion
  - a. Monk reported that the bid from Toby Manella/Hawaii Sprinkler and Lighting is pending information/pricing on a solar PV-approach to powering the sprinkler controllers.
  - b. Monk also reported that quotes from Jack Morgan/Ultimate Innovations for controllers based on batteries had been received. The high-end bid assumes full replacement of the current sprinkler system, including new piping throughout.
  - c. The bids both assume relocating the sprinklers from the street-side curbing to locating them in the middle of the lawn area.
  - d. Follow-up meetings with each bidder will be scheduled for May 15 & 16 to provide time for the bidders to present their proposals to the Board and for follow-up Q&A.
  - e. Next Steps for Irrigation Upgrade
    - i. Review PV-based proposal with Toby Manella, May 15 (All)
    - ii. Review Battery-based proposal with Jack Morgan, May 16 (All)
    - iii. Discuss merits/risks of each proposal, and reach decision (All)
- 2. Annual Tree Service from Love's Landscaping
  - a. Walkthrough conducted on April 8
  - b. Alexich will follow-up with Aisea/Love's Landscaping regarding quotes and schedule for outside scope trimming for neighboring yards
- 3. Overgrowth from properties bordering Common Area
  - a. Ultimate Innovations provided a quotation for removing the overgrowth.
  - b. Alexich will follow-up with neighbors that have overgrowth over their back walls to ask them to remove/trim. Concern is walls can be damaged if overgrowth is neglected.
  - c. Need to confirm the property line for members bordering the Common Area includes their back walls
  - d. Depending on neighbor cooperation in removing overgrowth, may need to consider rule change to address overgrowth and subsequent cost reimbursement billings
- 4. Specific request from Association Member in arrears to waive outstanding debts
  - Review of Member's account show outstanding debts for two years of annual dues (2016 and 2018), as well as unpaid attorney fees
  - b. Monk to provide additional detail and history on each of the line items
  - c. Consensus that outstanding dues and associated collection fees are not negotiable
- 5. Next Board Meetings on May 15/16 at 6:30pm to review Irrigation Upgrade bids with bidders, and the request of a member whose account is in collection to be excused from reimbursing the Association for legitimately incurred attorney fees.
